HIGHLIGHT OF CHILD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Pre-school education and primary school education are vital for development of children. Therefore SAVERA FOUNDATION is concentrating on Aanganwari centre and Govt schools with economic support of ILP (India Literacy project) during this year we have achieved the following



ACHIEVEMENT

- 176 children enrolled.
- 64 children reenrolled.
- 20 child clubs have been formed.
- 22 child protection committee have been formed.
- 25 teachers are aware of our initiative.
- 19 teachers are sensitive, some are taking extra classes some helped in establishing book bank.
- Children of 6 schools come to school in time.
- 7 villages Mata Samiti submitted application for reconstruction and construction of AWC.
- 13 AWC were provided kitchen set utensils.
- 80% SMC members are aware of their membership and roles.
- 200 poor children are using learning materials given by us.
- 32 Toilets constructed in schools.
- 118 people are capable to explain the RTE and their roles like 46 SMC members, 10 AWW, 42 community people, 21 mothers committee.

A STEP TOWARDS COMMUNITY INTITUTION BUILDING

SAVERA FOUNDATION since 2006 has been focusing on formation and development of community based. Therefore it has been putting energy to make the community aware on different social issues and different government social security schemes

During this financial year, SAVERA FOUNDATION formed 12 groups and total no of SHGs has become 34. Thus, 408 women have come under one umbrella. These groups would be a powerful tool in bringing planned social and economic change.





THE ACHIEVEMENT IN THIS THEMATIC AREA IS FOLLOWING.

- All Groups have Rs. 87800 with them.
- The amount of internal loan is Rs. 21300.
- The total amount is Rs. 130000.
- 10 SHGs have opened their bank accounts
- 16 child clubs have been formed. The total no of child clubs become 54.
- 204 children have been associated with child clubs this year
- The members of child clubs started sharing before Block development officer on their issues.
- 4 child protection committee have been formed and oriented on the roles and responsibilities

SAVERA FOUNDATION'S INITIATIVES IN THE FIELD OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT

SAVERA FOUNDATION's efforts in three trades computer, stitching and embroidery focus on helping youth to become employable. And our society will provide a platform for employing this to skilled work force.

We are covering rural youth for our skill development programme and we give priority for young girls and women. Our main purpose is to make our focused group self employed.

We also shared about PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL VIKASH YOJNA implemented through NATIONAL SKILL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. We discussed about Govt initiative towards skill development programme the objective of govt. initiative is to encourage skill development for youth and enable and mobilize a large number of Indian youth to take up skill training and become employable and earn their livelihood.

HEALTH- MALARIA, HIV/AIDS, TB

Status of health depends on some factors like per capita income, nutrition, sanitation safe drinking water, medical care facility employment etc. There is direct relation between health and development

Therefore our initiative is to aware and sensitive the deprived community on the factors influencing health.

As investment on health increase the productive capacity of the individual.

We also provide information to our target group related to JANANI SURAKSHA YOJNA, JANANI SHISHU SURAKSHA KARYAKARAM, village health and sanitation committee. We also discuss on material mortality rate, mother health, infant and child health

RESULTS

- Participants developed their understanding on symptoms and control of Malaria.
- Increase in number of villagers using mosquito net.
- 105 persons develop their understanding on HIV/AIDS
- 116 persons develop their understanding on TB



Livelihood promotion

We are working in Mica Mines area and about 30 years ago the livelihood of these people were dependent on Mica (a kind of mineral) but now a days, they are mainly dependent on agricultural product, they earn some minor forest product because of deforestation.

Women work hard to ensure food for the family. Therefore we formed and strengthen farmers clubs and imparted training to them on new methods and techniques of agriculture.



ACHIEVEMENT

- 38 farmers have been motivated and started producing alternative crops and increased their income Rs. 3000 per 1760 sq ft. Irrigated land.
- In 4 villages, farmers adopted the methods of pest management.
- 2 vermin compost beds have been prepared.
- 334 farmers are the members of these clubs in our project area.
- 4 farmer's group started collective purchasing of seeds and fertilizers.
- 10500 Kg vegetables have been produced by 244 farmers through kitchen garden.
- 100 families received plants of Lemon, Banana, Mango, Guava, Black Berry (Jamun).
- 72 farmers received training on SRI and develop their capacity to more paddies and ensure 100% germination and increase in the production of paddy.

ENVIRONMENT

Environment now is very important issue for all human beings. Survival of human beings is totally depends on environment.

As we have observed that the level of pollution (water air land) is increasing day by day because of our physical development and industry growth

We are taking stones for construction work and destroying mountains and misusing natural resources. We are cutting tree for our personal and commercial use.

That's why we must take care of our environment. We have been making efforts to make aware the community in the adverse effort of pollution. We conducted orientation programme for forest protection committee. We distributed sapling for plantation. We are in the process of capacitating our target group to take action to control pollution.

Protection of national resources by conservation reduces the amount of any hazardous substance.



WOMEN'S RIGHT

As per the VISION and MISSION of SAVERA FOUNATION, we have been focusing on women's rights. Particularly, in our target villages we find a lot of women' problems.

We have observed that the women of rural society are still lacking recognition of their domestic work. They are being ignored by the society. They are denied of their right in the family, access to better health, decision making process and ownership in the family.

Girl child education, gender equality and leadership quality among women are our main issues related to women's empowerment. Therefore we have been making efforts to form and strengthen SHG, adolescent girl group and girl child participation in child right clubs. We have organized following activities.

CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

We organize this activity every year and accordingly we conducted this activity on 8th March 2016. We organized a rally from Mansadih to Tilki-Maran. 710 women of 20 villages participated in this rally. They gave a memorandum to Mukhiya. During this rally women shared their views and spoke slogans.
