This year with the help of FVTRS we trained rural girls on computer, embroidery-cum-zero training and Tailoring, as these trainings provide immediate benefit to these girls, who so often are burdened by domestic chores at the expense of attending school and other opportunities for growth. SAVERA FOUNDATION worked on becoming a link for the education of the children. We are trying to put all our efforts to work in this DIFFICULT TO REACH area to bring ray of hope among the people that united we can do and achieve many things. SAVERA FOUNDATION looks forward to working with more communities.

## **Vision**

We envisage to establish a society free from injustice, and exploitation where Dalits, Tribals and deprived can live their lives peacefully and in harmony with nature.

## **Mission:**

To enables individuals and community within the working area that they can fully participate in the life, decision and structures of the community and have equal opportunity in development process.

## **Aims & Objectives:**

The objective or purpose of Savera Foundation is:

- To help the poor and weaker section of the society particularly widow, orphan the needy, aged and destitute.
- To work for conservation of solar energy and other natural resources.
- To work for the women and children for future generation.
- To preserve and protect the environment for future generation.
- To promote the health status of the deprived people and make efforts to eradicate polio, malaria and stop spread of HIV/AIDS.
- To promote and take up literacy programme, adult education project.

## **Activities:**

Projects under implementation:

1. **Skill development for unemployed youth :**



The purpose of skill development training is to prepare unemployed youth, an employable work force or self employed so that they could earn a decent living in their life.

The organization is carrying out skill training on three trades- stitching and embroidery, mobile repairing and motor cycle repairing. School dropout girls and young women are given preference to take up the skill training.



Some of the youths have received employment with decent wages and quite many have taken up self employment.

## 2. Right to Education for children:

Pre and primary school education is vital for all round development of children. Hence, SAVERA FOUNDATION has targeted Anganwari centers and a few govt. primary schools with financial support of ILP (India Literacy project) and Terre Des Homes and DKA, Austria .

Emphasis was made to ensure quality education of children and provide regular mid day meal, Re enroll drop out and support weak children to cope up with rest of the children in the class.



## 3. Promotion of Livelihood:

We are working in Mica Mines area and about 30 years ago the livelihood dependent on Mica (a kind of mineral) but now a days, people mainly depend on agriculture and on minor forest produce as an additional income. Women and men labour hard to ensure food for the family. Therefore, we formed and strengthened self help groups, farmers club



and imparted training, initiated improved methods of agriculture.

Effort also was being made to mobilize government facilities – for demonstration to selected formers for kharif crops, vegetables and horticultures.



#### 4. Child line for children in Need or Distress:

A Toll free No. 1089 is being launched for the children in Need or Distress to address their problems. This number is widely published in three blocks area- Gawan, Tisri and Deori so that people can use the number in case of need. This number is useful even for the victims themselves. The victims are referred to line department of the government for remedial measures.

Under Child line cases handled are – missing, orphans, child marriage, child labour, trafficking, child migration and support differently abled children to avail govt. Help.

So far the organisation has resolved 29 cases and rescued & availed relief to the victims. This toll free nos. is opened for 24 hours.



Achievements:

- Skill training to youths 110 youths under training on Tailoring, mobile and motor cycle repair
- Formation of 23SHGs and 20 Kisan Clubs
- Distribution of fruit bearing plants among 100 Families like – mango, lemon, guava, coconut and kaju.
- Awareness building to the community on land, water, forest
- Promotion of Natural pesticide (NEEM Leaf) and Organic manure and organic farming, 42 Farmers are using Natural Pesticides to protect the crops from disease.
- Enable the aged and differently abled person to avail -Old age pension, widow pension, differently abled pension
- Campaign against HIV/AIDS particularly for migrant labourers
